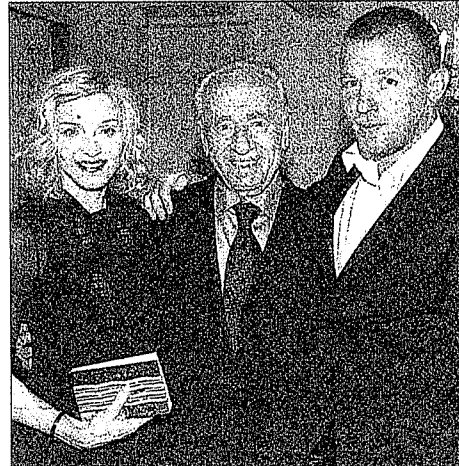

NEW York magazine art critic **Jerry Saltz** attacks former Guggenheim Museum director **Thomas Krens** in this week's issue, calling him "reckless, destructive, myopic and misguided," for supporting notorious anti-Israeli nation United Arab Emirates and its decision to build a 300,000-square-foot

edifice designed by **Frank Gehry**. "Numerous government sites warn that Israeli passport holders and travelers whose passports bear Israeli stamps will be denied entry visas to the Emirates. Thus, the Guggenheim — founded by a Jewish family, an institution with Jewish curators and scores of works by Jewish artists, designed by the Jewish Gehry — isn't really welcome either," Saltz writes in the mag.
